### LOCATIONS & TRAVEL MOOD

This tour will focus on the naturalistic aspects of Calabria, by being a "mountain in the middle of the sea" ... indeed, mountains in the middle of the seas! Because in truth the three great mountain massifs that characterize Calabria have different origins and compositions, just as the two seas are profoundly different from each other.

The geomorphological peculiarities determine the Calabrian crops and cultures, creating a multiform and multifaceted region from every point of view: the barren and rocky mountain territory of the Pollino becomes a forest in Sila, the rocky coasts of the Tyrrhenian become expanses of sand on the Ionian, the typical crops of cold mountain areas alternate with the botanical gardens of the valleys. And when the mountain and the sea meet, they give rise to specialties that are unique in the world, such as "Sardella," sea fish preserved in the mountains!

The cultures, the rites, the traditions...sometimes remained unchanged over the centuries, as in the closed and inaccessible territories of the Pollino area. Also, traditions of unique wine production methods (passito muscat of Saracena); sometimes open to the world, welcoming, with that welcome that the center of the Mediterranean, cradle and path of all great civilizations, can give.....It's time to start the journey between two seas and three peaks: open your eyes to wonder.
